

# 2020 Graham Division II Sectional Wrestling Tournament

The window for entries opens at 2:00 pm on Sunday, January 26 and must be submitted by 7:00 pm, Thursday, February 27, 2020.

1. Entries must be submitted using the Online Entry Form at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com)  
Create your account early and enter your master alphabetic roster. **Schools will be subject to a \$50 fine for wrestlers entered after the deadline. No entries will be accepted after weigh-ins begin.** (See OHSAA Regulations <https://ohsaaweb.blob.core.windows.net/files/Sports/Wrestling/WRindTourneyRegs.pdf>)
2. Please note the following details on [baumspage.com](http://baumspage.com)
  - a) All User Accounts from last year are still active.
  - b) After login, the coach will be able to add multiple teams/sports/genders to the same account!
3. Go to [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com) and click **Online Entry** or **Login** to access your account.
  - a) If you did not have an account last year, use **Apply** to create your account.
  - b) If you had an account last year, you can login using that e-mail address and password.
    - i) **Please note: Passwords are case-sensitive!**
    - ii) If you don't know your password, click the **Forget your password?** link to have a temporary password e-mailed to you.
4. Use • **Coaches | Select Teams** to select your school from the drop-down list.
  - a) Click **Get Available School Teams** | click **Select Sport** in the dropdown below | highlight your sport | then click **Make me the Coach**.
  - b) If your school is not listed or somebody else has already claimed your team, use **My Tools | Online Help** and submit the appropriate **Help Request**.
5. Use • **Coaches | Wrestling | Modify Athletes** to enter athletes to your alphabetic roster.
  - a) You may enter athletes one at a time by entering first name, last name, and grade, then **Add Athlete**.
    - i) Type all names in upper and lower case. **\*Please check all entries carefully!**
  - b) Or you can import your complete roster by pasting them from an Excel file. Use one row per athlete: **First Name, Last Name, and Grade**. Highlight and paste into textbox, then click **Import Athletes**.
6. Use • **Coaches | Wrestling | Submit Rosters** to enter them in a tournament.
  - a) Select your team | click **Get Available Events** | Select an event | click **Get Roster**.
    - i) For each weight class, click **Select a Wrestler** and select the athlete from the drop-down list.
    - ii) Enter seeding information as requested. **Enter records for all wrestlers!**
  - b) Click **Submit Roster** to save. Use **Get Printable Roster** to print a copy for your records.
  - c) If a name or grade is not correct or an athlete is missing, use • **Coaches | Wrestling | Modify Athletes** to make the correction, then submit your entries again.
7. **Event Rosters can only be submitted or corrected while the "Entry Window" is open!**
  - a) The window closes automatically **precisely at the time and date listed. (February 27 at 7:00pm)**
  - b) **Submit Rosters** early and return to make changes **anytime before** the window closes.
  - c) **Entries cannot be edited or submitted online after the window closes.**
8. **If there are any problems with the Online Form**, click the **Contact Us** link and submit a **Help Request**. **Please allow up to 8 hours for a response! \*Most responses will be in less than 4 hours.**

## Graham Division II –Entry Procedure and Deadlines

**Thursday, February 27, 2020**

1. Online Roster (**Submit by 7:00 pm on Thursday, February 27<sup>th</sup>**)
  - a. Include **grade and current records for all wrestlers along with OHSAA State or District placement last year.**
  - b. Print the Confirmation Form! Correct records on the form and bring to the meeting (if needed).

**Friday, February 28, 2020, Seeding Meeting 3:30 pm.**

**Seeding Procedure -- Please read the following information carefully:**

For the Sectional Tournament, the competing wrestlers must:

- A. Be listed on the Weight Certification Alpha Master Report.
- B. Wrestle only at the Alpha Master Weight class or weight class above as specified by the rules.

After 7:00 PM on Thursday no substitutions will be permitted with the following exceptions:

- A. Academic or disciplinary ineligibility.
- B. Family matters that necessitate a wrestler being withdrawn.
- C. A medical emergency or illness experienced by the wrestler. Not passing the skin check is a medical matter.

Seeding Information and Criteria:

- A. We will seed up to six wrestlers in each class if credentials warrant. Once a wrestler is nominated for seeding, they cannot be withdrawn from the seed by the coach (Board Action)
- B. Seeding will be based on the following criteria:
  1. Returning state placer (1-3) at any weight class.
  2. Returning state placer (4-8) at any weight class. A “New” (Freshman or upper classman that was not a contender last year) wrestler that has more than 25 wins and has defeated a wrestler listed above him on the list and has a higher winning percentage will be seeded above the returning state place winner at any weight class (4-8). \*The coach must e-mail the credentials to the manager.
  3. Returning district placer (1-6) at any weight class. A “New” (Freshman or upper classman that was not a contender last year) wrestler that has more than 20 wins and has a higher winning percentage than the returning district place winner will be seeded above the returning district place winner at any weight class (1-6).
    - Tie-breakers:
      - The higher placer at each level earns the higher seed.
      - If two or more wrestlers have identical place finishes, the wrestler returning at the same weight earns the higher seed.
      - Previous year’s tournament place finish MUST have been at an OHSAA tournament. A returning placer can be from Division I, II, or III.
  4. Current overall record (12-match minimum and .500 or better winning percentage).
    - If there is a tie in winning percentage the wrestler with the most wins will receive the higher seed.
    - If that does not break the tie, a coin-flip will determine the seed.
  5. Although criteria will be considered and used for pre-ranking seeds, a coach’s vote will be the final determination. Head-to-head competition and common tournament placement for wrestlers listed should be a consideration.
- C. The **Seed Nomination List** will only include wrestlers that meet the OHSAA Seeding Criteria. A wrestler may only be added to, or deleted from, the list if there was an error in reporting his credentials.
- D. The brackets will be drawn during the weigh-ins assuming the wrestlers entered in the weight class will make weight and clear the skin check.
  1. The bracket will not be official until the weigh-in is finished.
  2. If there is change in the entries for a weight class, the bracket for that weight class will be redrawn. Seeded wrestlers will rotate upward and a replacement, if available, will be randomly drawn.
